**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Registration will be at 12 noon on Friday and 3 a.m. to 2 p.m. ON SATURDAY. Entry fee for all events is established at \$37.00.  
 Event Champion - \$3.00 for each entry  
 Class winners - \$10.00 for each entry  
 1 to 5 entries - One winner  
 3-10 entries Split 60/40  
 11 or more entries - Split 50/30/20 in addition to regular entry fees, NSSA fees of \$3.00 per 100 targets and NSSA fees of \$2.00 per 100 targets will be charged.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Shoot management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry, including termination of entries if all squads are filled. Management also reserves the right to alter this program within the limits of the current NSSA rules.

Spectators and contestants assume all risk of accidents to self or damage to or loss of property. For safety reasons and to minimize distractions to shooters, no recovery of spent shells is allowed once the shells hit the ground during the days of this shoot. In addition, no unauthorized personal are allowed to adjust the skeet machines.

This is a guaranteed purse to the champion in events (2,3,4 & 5), with the champion to be determined in each event by the highest score and results of any shoot-offs. Purse guarantee is guaranteed minimum to the champion. If the class purse payoff is higher than the minimum, the higher amount will be awarded.

All ties will result in a shoot-off unless otherwise stated, with doubles at station 3, 4, 5, miss and out by station.

Food will be available at the club Saturday and Sunday. Cocktail party and dinner Saturday following shoot-offs.

Practice fields open Friday at 12 noon.
