General Information: This shoot is limited to the first 30 shooters who pre-register. \$50 deposit per shooter required for pre-registration. Deposit is refundable prior to June 9, 2006. Preference will be given to 5 Gun Shooters. For more information contact shoot chairman, Bill Wayne at 660-747-5728 or info@cedarcroft.com.

NSSA and MSSA Daily Fees: They are included in the entry fees.

Rules and Regulations: This shoot is authorized and registered with the MSSA & NSSA. All rules and regulations will be strictly observed. AAA and AA classified shooters will compete together in AA class.

Liability: Shooters and guests shall hold The Springfield Rod and Gun Club, and it's agents harmless for any loss or injury. Entry or participation in this tournament shall be deemed as agreeing to this provision.

Classification: Classifications will be based on current rules and regulations of the NSSA. HOA classification will be based upon a shooters FOUR-GUN average as of the last reclassification. The shooter must present a current classification card at registration with all average scores calculated. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify current classification prior to departing registration area.

Ties: All ties for championships will be shot off. All will be shot off with doubles on stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station.

Program Changes: Shoot management reserves the right to make changes in this program without notification, recourse, or protest. Shoot management additionally reserves the right to refuse entry to any contestant, or cause the withdrawal of any contestant, who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the normal operation of this shoot.

Food and Beverages: Food and Beverages will be available for lunch on Saturday and Sunday at no cost to the shooter and their guest. The Springfield Rod & Gun Club will host a cocktail party on Friday starting at 5:00 PM. Also the Club will host cocktail party then dinner on Saturday starting at 5:00 PM at no additional cost to the shooter and their guest.

Practice Rounds and Ammunition: Practice rounds may be shot as long as fields are available. Cost of practice rounds is \$3.00. Hand loads are permitted per NSSA rules and regulations. Proof and shoot-off shells are the responsibility of the shooter.

Protest Committee: The members of the Protest Committee are James Cannon, Steve Krebs and Dave Runyon.

Money Awards: The winners checks will be mailed. For Events One through Six:

- A. Event Champion receives \$20 more than the highest class winner.
- B. Event Runner-up receives \$10 more than the highest class winner.
- C. Event Champion and Runner-up are ineligible for class purse.
- D. \$8 returned to class.
 - 1. 1-5 shooters: one place (100%)
 - 2. 6-10 shooters: two places (60%/40%)
 - 3. 11+ shooters: three places (50%/30%20%)

Concurrents: All concurrents are honors only.

- 1. 1-5 shooters: one place
- 2. 6-10 shooters: two places
- 3. 11+ shooters: three places

Withdrawals: Refunds will be made only for withdrawals due to emergency. The protest committee will make the final determination regarding refunds.

Squading: Five-Person squads will be used. Squads will start promptly. Per NSSA Rule II-A-4, squads will proceed without tardy shooters. An attempt will be made to re-squaded tardy shooters, otherwise they will forfeit.

Drawings: On Friday and Saturday evening there will be drawings for prizes. All shooters with paid entries will be included. Must be present to win.
